Internship

Department: Education

The Schiele Education Department provides professional development for teachers, publishes informational and curricular materials for schools, fosters mutually beneficial relationships between schools and museums, and disseminates to a regional audience of adults and young people information about the Museum's educational programming and materials. The office also provides services to support and advance education within the museums, offices and research ranges of the Schiele. The office accepts interns in several areas:

- Developing and coordinating educational projects, such as the collaboration with the Gaston County Public Schools, and summer programs for teachers
- Publishing materials for teachers
- Coordinating special events
- Developing and maintaining electronic outreach services, e.g., over the Internet

Term: Most internships are for a minimum of a semester or a summer term, at 15 hours per week or more.

Application: Full application should include a completed application form, resume, two letters of recommendation, a short essay describing your interest in a Schiele internship, and academic transcripts.

Deadline: Applications are reviewed throughout the year, but it is preferred that applications for fall semester are received by August 1st; winter/spring semester by December 1st; and summer semester by April 1st.
