Who can participate?

Scarecrow Description:

- Scarecrow "t" frames will be provided by museum. You will need a truck or empty van if you want to construct your scarecrow off site.
- Contestants are responsible for all other scarecrow materials.
- Scarecrows must be able to withstand outdoor weather conditions.
- Scarecrows entries must have a name or title.
 - The museum will provide a standard sized sign to identify each entry. The sign will list the name of the scarecrow entry and the name of the individual or group who created it.
- When designing your scarecrow, please keep it "family-friendly." No political or overly violent scarecrows will be accepted or displayed.
- The Schiele Museum reserves the right to reject or remove any scarecrows deemed inappropriate and does not accept responsibility for loss or damage to any of the displays.
- All entrants agree to allow use of their name(s) and photos for promotional purposes.
- Creativity is strongly encouraged!

Timeline:

- Sep. 1 – 24: Online entry and payment for Scarecrow spot.
- Sep. 30: Scarecrow Entry Drop-Off between 10 AM – 12 PM at the museum. Schiele staff will place scarecrows on the trail.
- Sep. 30 @ Noon: Deadline for scarecrows to be built and submitted to the museum
- Oct. 2 - 16: Scarecrow Walk event. Scarecrows must remain on display.
- Oct. 16: Winners announced.
- **Oct. 18: Scarecrows picked up and removed from museum by 3 PM.** Any remaining scarecrows not collected will be discarded.

Judging:

- Museum guests can vote for their favorite Scarecrow.
- Winners will be determined by a committee appointed by the museum. Judges decisions are final.
- Scarecrows will be judged based on creativity, traditional homemade design, and use of agricultural materials. Late entries will not be considered.
- No handouts, promotional materials, or free giveaways can be associated with entries.
- Winners will be announced on Schiele Museum social media. Winners will be contacted to receive their prize.
