

**Environmental Science Internship** This internship is aimed towards individuals interested in environmental science education in a museum and along its trail. Interns will create educational cart programs implementing them indoors and outdoors. They will also aid in Kids Quest, our afterschool program, and/or Summer Camps as well as special events. Interns can expect to gain experience in program development, program implementation, plant and animal identification, and trail maintenance.

The physical aspect of this internship involves walking the trail and performing slight maintenance and clean up.

- Interns will be working both indoors and outdoors, and in a variety of weather conditions
- Interns may be asked to lift up to 50lbs and/or carry objects around the museum and trail
- Must be able to work independently and improvise when necessary to provide quality programming
- Educational programs will occur daily and will be for a diversity of age groups
- Weekend, holiday, and occasional evening availability is required
