

## **General Education Internship**

This internship is designed for those looking for a well-rounded experience in museum education. Interns will observe, participate in, and teach a variety of museum educational programs across all disciplines that the Schiele Museum covers. These include both on-site and outreach programs and may include program such as Life in a Catawba Village, Animal Dissections, Gemstone Mining, Weather, etc. Interns will also help with many of the day to day operations of the museum and will have the chance to work with a number of different museum departments. Summer interns will assist in the planning, development, and implementation of summer camps.

Other things to know about this internship:

- Interns will be working both indoors and outdoors, and in a variety of weather conditions
- Must be able to work independently and improvise when necessary to provide quality programming
- Interns may be asked to lift up to 50lbs and/or carry objects around the museum, nature trail, and some offsite locations
- Interns may be loading material in and out of vehicles (golf carts, vans, etc.)
- Weekend, holiday, and occasional evening availability is required
