

Outreach Education Internship

This internship is designed for those looking for a well-rounded experience in museum outreach education. Interns will observe, participate in, and teach a variety of museum educational programs across all disciplines that the Schiele Museum covers at a variety of facilities in the surrounding community. These include programs such as Indians and Pioneers, Animal Dissections, Gemstone Mining, Weather, Animal Adaptations, Fossil Labs, etc. Interns will also spend time on-site at the Schiele Museum preparing for outreach programs which may include organizing, preparing, cleaning or moving program materials. This internship requires a flexible schedule as programs are booked based on the client's time needs that can range from early morning to late evening.

Other things to know about this internship:

- Interns will be working both indoors and outdoors, and in a variety of weather conditions
- Must be able to work independently and improvise when necessary to provide quality programming
- Interns may be asked to lift up to 50lbs and/or carry objects around the museum and off-site locations
- Interns may be loading material in and out of vehicles (golf carts, vans, etc.)

Weekend, holiday, and occasional evening availability is required
