After School Counselors support the effective delivery of educational programs and activities for children in rising 1st-6th grade afterschool Monday - Friday. Counselors participate in staff training and perform various afterschool duties. Duties include but are not limited to assisting Schiele Museum Staff, mentoring and monitoring youth in homework and programs, assisting with extended care, and leading activities. This position reports to the Youth Program Specialist.

Responsibilities

- Assist with program preparation and clean up
- Support and participate in staff training events and activities
- Lead or Co-lead games, activities, and crafts
- With guidance, develop, plan, prepare and deliver various outdoor/indoor activities, for afterschool, that are developmentally appropriate, engaging, fun, and safe

- Ensure all Schiele Museum policies and procedures, including health and safety protocols, are implemented, and always enforced.
- Assist with other afterschool duties such as sign in and sign out process.
- Drive campers in a 15-passenger van to and from school and field trips.
- Perform other duties as requested by supervisor or leadership staff
